INTRODUCTION

One of the world's largest lagoons, Truk is enclosed by a 225km barrier reef, covers more than 2000 square kilometres and is home to an entire Japanese fleet, sunk in 1944.

Frozen in time, complete with sake cups and skeletons, jeeps and tanks still tied on board and fighter planes still waiting in the hangars, the area is an underwater museum. Nowhere else in the world are there so many wrecks in close proximity situated in shallow water, many visible whilst snorkelling and there are several onshore wartime locations to visit.

Coron Bay

Located in north Palawan in the most westerly part of the Philippines, Coron Bay is renowned for some of the best wreck diving in the world. There are other interesting dive sites to explore in the area; but it's the vessels of an anchored Japanese supply fleet, which were bombed by a massive air strike in September 1944, that divers go to discover. The majority lie at a depth of 25 metres. With a maximum of 40 metres, they are accessible to divers of all abilities.





Begin your stay at Sangat Island Dive Resort (7 nights)

Located on the southwest of the island on a 300 metre stretch of pure white sand, surrounded by towering limestone cliffs and majestic coconut palms, Sangat Island Resort is one of the best kept secrets of ecoconscious paradise seekers and diving enthusiasts throughout the world. The tropical waters teem with aquatic life and the historically important WWll Japanese shipwrecks of Coron Bay are minutes from your doorstep.

Situated in the Calamian Islands, the most westerly in the Philippines, the resort features 14 native styled accommodations built from locally sourced materials with hand-woven bamboo wall panels, split bamboo flooring and cogon grass or nipa palm roofing. Choose form the cozy, beach or hillside chalet to the affordable family-oriented bungalow suite units, the stately hilltop chalet or the spectacular Lambingan Villa. Each accommodation is well ventilated by large mosquito-netted windows and includes western-styled bathroom facilities, ceiling fans, ample lighting, and 220-volt electrical outlets.

All meals are included during your stay and are served in a buffet-styled environment with seafood, meat and vegetarian options available daily. Facilities include a dive centre, restaurant and bar, souvenir shop and fitness centre. If you have time for anything but diving, there's plenty to choose from - water sports, island

hopping, nature treks, rock climbing, bird watching, hot springs and massage therapy. Your stay here will be restful, adventure-filled and memorable.

Frozen in time, complete with sake cups and skeletons, jeeps and tanks still tied on board, and fighter planes still waiting in the hangars, the area has been declared an underwater museum. Incredible corals in a kaleidoscope of colours and shapes attract divers of all levels, while schooling tropical fish smother the ships.

Nowhere else in the world are there so many wrecks in close proximity, situated in clear shallow water. Many of the wrecks are visible while snorkelling and there are several on-shore wartime locations to visit.



Begin your stay at Blue Lagoon Dive Resort (8 nights)

Away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life, the resort is situated on a palm fringed point of Moen Island with breathtaking views of the most famous lagoon in the world, Truk.

Accommodation is in two low storey buildings set in lush tropical gardens amongst coconut palms. The 54 rooms are comfortable and spacious featuring air-conditioning, en-suite bathroom, a TV, small fridge and a balcony on which to relax and enjoy the stunning sunset. Other facilities include a restaurant, beach bar, dive lockers, small shop and WiFi is available.

The family run dive centre has been welcoming divers since 1973. Daily boat dives operate to the historic wrecks of Truk Lagoon. There are over 40 to discover and some are easily accessed by snorkellers. Nitrox and Trimix are available. A limited supply of helium and sodasorb are kept in stock, but need to be booked in advance.

Once we receive your deposit and your booking form is complete (with full details of everyone travelling on your booking), we will set about getting all the arrangements confirmed for your holiday.
